Roger Barnes was born in Baltimore, MD, June 11, 1974, to Robert and Shirley Barnes. He was raised in Edgewood, where he continues to call his home, along with his children Tyler and Brianna.

At the early age of 3, Robert and Shirley ignited Rogers's passion for the sport of bowling. He then joined his first league, Alley Cats, at Fairlanes Edgewood.

His passion for the sport shined through on April 27, 1991, when he bowled 257-264-279 for his first 800 set. Roger became the first YABA youth to bowl an 800 set in the state of Maryland. The fire continued a few months later, when he bowled his first 300.

After graduating from Edgewood High School in 1992, Roger then turned his focus to adult leagues. On September 4, 1992, the second game of his first adult league, Roger bowled his first adult sanctioned 300. In the winter of 1996, his passion and development for bowling continued to shine. Roger set the house record at AMF Edgewood with an 858 set.

Roger has a plethora of tournament achievements and has carried a 220 or better average for the past 20 years. He has 35 300 games, 14 800 series and 1 800 sports series achievements. He along with Mike Wheeler, Rich McFadden, Bill Barlow and Bruce Hollen Jr, set the State tournament team record of 3656 shot at Forest Hill Lanes.

Therefore, for his outstanding achievements in the game of American Tenpins, the Maryland State USBC Association is proud to induct Roger Barnes into its Hall of Fame in the Superior Performance Category.
